Address Lookup Feature on User Interface (UI)

VPTIB-04

In VehiclePath's ongoing efforts to improve system reliability and network performance, we have instituted a change in the User Interface (UI) that affects how the customer can lookup addresses attached to tracking data on the 'Locations' section of the UI.

Addresses will no longer appear on the mapping portion of the UI by default. To see the addresses for a vehicle's tracking data, you can either:

- 1) Click the 'Addresses' button on the UI. (see below) When the Addresses box is checked, the address data will fill in beneath the associated data point.

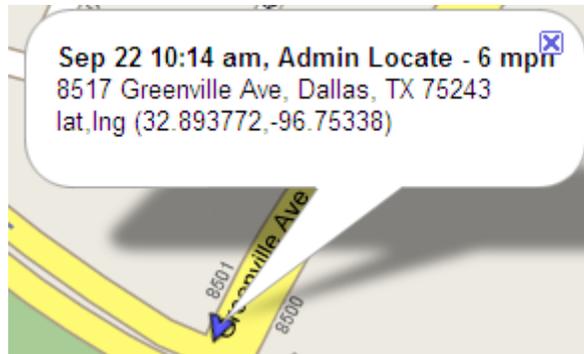

Customers can also select the 'History' button to generate a history report that has all of the addresses listed with the tracking data.
